How to Make Hand Sanitizer

We will use:

2/3 cup of 91% rubbing alcohol also known as isopropyl alcohol

• 1/3 cup of pure aloe vera gel, preferably without additives

• An essential oil of your choosing, I will be using lavender

A mixing bowl

A spoon

A funnel

• And a plastic container for our finished product

Reggie: First, mix the alcohol and aloe vera gel in the bowl.

Reggie: Stir until the mixture is completely smooth.

Sierrah: If you prefer your sanitizer to be thicker then add a spoon full of aloe vera.

Sierrah: You can also thin it out by adding a spoon full of alcohol.

Reggie: Next, we will add our essential oil.

Reggie: We will add one drop at a time, stirring as we go.

Sierrah: After about 8 drops, smell to determine if you like the scent.
